WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant for \$215,928 from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, for the period of January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, This project includes a contract with PHFE for \$184,998 plus \$22,200 (12% contingency in accordance with DPH policy) for the period of January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, The aim of this project is to provide technical assistance for men who have sex with men (MSM) related surveillance and intervention to the National Center for AIDS/STD Control and Prevention/Chinese Ministry of Health (NCAIDS/MOH) for the Foundation-supported program on HIV prevention; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the Bill and Melinda Gates

Foundation requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is

hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the funds will be used to partially reimburse DPH for three existing positions, including Senior Physician Specialist (Job Class #2232) at .05 FTE, Manager I (Job Class #0922) at .05 FTE, Epidemiologist I (Job Class #2802) at .10 FTE; and,

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$4,865; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$215,928 from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement, pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when the agreement expires.
