SUPPORTING AB 592, WHICH WILL, IN PART, TREBLE THE DAILY COMPENSATION PAID TO JURORS AND REQUIRE COURTS TO REIMBURSE JURORS FOR CHILD CARE.

WHEREAS, The present compensation for jurors coupled with a lack of child care options may be an impediment to recruiting jurors from a cross-section of the community; and,

WHEREAS, Although many states pay as much as fifty dollars per day for jury duty, California only pays its jurors five dollars per day; and,

WHEREAS, The state's current compensation rate has not been adjusted since it was set in 1957; and,

WHEREAS, The low rate of jury compensation fuels public perception of this service as an onerous and under appreciated duty; and,

WHEREAS, Assembly member Carole Migden's bill, AB 592, would treble the rate at which jurors are paid, thus demonstrating the value that California places on each individual citizen performing his or her civic duty, ensuring at a minimum that jurors are reimbursed for out of pocket expenses incurred while serving as jurors; and,

WHEREAS, This bill would also ensure that persons with dependent care issues can afford to temporarily replace themselves as the caregiver; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, The City and County of San Francisco does hereby support AB 592; and be it FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco does hereby urge the state legislature to adopt and the Governor to sign this bill into law; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco does hereby request that a copies of this resolution be sent to our state representatives and to Governor Gray Davis.
