[Accept-Expend Grant]

Resolution authorizing the Public Utilities Commission to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$250,000 from the California Dental Association Foundation, Inc. for the design and construction of the Sunol Valley Fluoridation Facility.

WHEREAS, the grant will provide for the partial reimbursement of San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) expenses associated with the design and construction of the Sunol Valley Fluoridation Facility (SVFF); and,

WHEREAS, the SFPUC is required to fluoridate the San Francisco distribution system to comply with Title 22 of the California Code of Regulations; and,

WHEREAS, the 1-year Fluoridation Feasibility Study conducted by the SFPUC, which included an engineering/technical evaluation and a comprehensive public outreach program, was closely coordinated with the Bay Area Water Users Association (BAWUA); and,

WHEREAS, per Resolution No. 02-0021 (January 22, 2002), the Public Utilities Commission approved the SFPUC Fluoridation Improvements Project (or SVFF); and,

WHEREAS, the final engineering design of the SVFF, which was initiated by the SFPUC Utilities Engineering Bureau in May 2002, will be completed in January 2003; and,

WHEREAS, the estimated total cost for the design and construction of the SVFF is \$2.8 million and is fully funded in the existing Capital Improvement Program; and,

WHEREAS, per Resolution No. 02-0159 (August 13, 2002), the Public Utilities

Commission approved the acceptance of \$250,000 in grant funding from the California Dental Association Foundation, Inc. for partial reimbursement of the design and construction of the

SVFF; and authorized the SFPUC General Manager to seek final approval of that grant funding from the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, the SFPUC proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the General Manager of the SFPUC be authorized to accept and expend a grant of \$250,000 from the California Dental Association Foundation, Inc. for the design and construction of the SVFF.
