WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency has extensive expertise in the provision of transportation services, including routing decisions, and in soliciting and overseeing contracts related to transportation; and

WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency is one of the top transportation agencies in the United States with respect to its understanding of vehicle emission and alternative fuel bus technology options, especially with respect to short and medium term implementation possibilities; and,

WHEREAS, The School District currently provides transportation services through its contract with Laidlaw Transit, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, The Laidlaw Transit, Inc. contract for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 is approximately \$19 million, based on bus service utilization; and

WHEREAS, Approximately 8500 general education students are transported under the Laidlaw contract, as well as about 1600 special needs students who receive all special needs transportation services, including transportation to therapy services; now, therefore, be it
