[Relocation of laundry services to Oyster Point.]

Resolution urging the Department of Administrative Services and other City departments to expeditiously implement the relocation of laundry services for San Francisco General Hospital and Laguna Honda Hospital to the laundry facility at Oyster Point.

WHEREAS, at the March 6 meeting of the Budget Committee, the Committee's members unanimously rejected a Proposition J certification to subcontract laundry services for Laguna Honda Hospital and limited a Proposition J certification to subcontract laundry March 30, 2004 services for San Francisco General Hospital until June 30. 2003: and

WHEREAS, rejection and limitation of these certifications was based in part on the fact that the current subcontractor for San Francisco General Hospital's laundry services does not pay its workers a Living Wage and has been under investigation by the Mayor's Office of Contract Administration; and

WHEREAS, a feasible alternative to contracting out laundry services for these hospitals has been identified, in which an existing laundry facility at Oyster Point is upgraded for operation; and

WHEREAS, the current laundry facility at Laguna Honda Hospital is scheduled to be demolished in the coming months to allow for the reconstruction of the entire hospital; and

WHEREAS, if the Oyster Point facility is not operational by the scheduled date for the demolition of the Laguna Honda laundry, and hence no alternative exists for the provision of laundry services for residents of Laguna Honda, the Hospital's construction project must incur costly delays; and

SUPERVISOR PESKIN, DALY, DUFTY, HALL BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, in the Fall of 2002, the Department of Public Health issued a Request for Proposals to design, furnish, install and maintain a laundry facility at Oyster Point; and

WHEREAS, a single qualified bid was received from Western State Design, which proposed a credible plan to provide laundry services for San Francisco General Hospital and Laguna Honda Hospital at a cost less than the current operation of Laguna Honda laundry facility and the contracting out of laundry services for San Francisco General Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the operation of a laundry facility at Oyster Point will meet the objectives of providing cost-effective laundry services while continuing to pay employees a Living Wage; so therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Administrative expeditiously complete Services to immediately commence negotiations with the University of California at San Francisco for the lease at Oyster Point and with Western State Design for the design, construction and maintenance of the laundry facility at Oyster Point; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges all City departments involved in the provision of laundry services at Laguna Honda and SFGH and the Laguna Honda replacement project to expeditiously implement the relocation of laundry services to Oyster Point.
