2 OPPOSING THE REQUEST FOR THE TRANSFER OF A TYPE 21 OFF-SALE GENERAL ALCOHOLIC
3 BEVERAGE CONTROL LICENSE FOR YASIN ALABDY FOR THUNDER GROCERY FROM, 53 MASON
4 STREET TO 30 MASON STREET, AND DETERMINING THAT IT WILL NOT SERVE THE PUBLIC
5 CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY OF THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO,
6 IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 23958.4 OF THE CALIFORNIA BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONS CODE.

8 WHEREAS, Yasin Aladby is seeking the transfer of a Type 21 off-sale general alcoholic beverage control
9 license from 53 Mason Street to 30 Mason Street; and,

10 WHEREAS, At the Small Business, Economic Vitality and Consumer Services Committee meeting of
11 March 4, 1999, residents of the area testified against the transfer of a liquor license at this location; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Police Department reports the area has an undue concentration of licensed premises and
13 has a high crime rate; and

14 WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license application be denied; now,
15 therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors opposes the transfer of a Type 21 off-sale general alcoholic
17 beverage control license to Yasin Aladby for Thunder Grocery from 53 Mason Street to 30 Mason Street, and
18 determines that it will not serve the public convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San
19 Francisco, in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors respectfully requests that the Department of
21 Alcoholic Beverage Control deny this application.


