URGING THE CALIFORNIA STATE LEGISLATURE AND GOVERNOR-ELECT GRAY DAVIS TO APPROVE ASSEMBLY BILL 26 AND SENATE BILL 75

WHEREAS, Existing law sets forth the requirements of a valid marriage and specifies the rights and obligations of spouses during marriage, but does not define or sanction domestic partnerships; and,

WHEREAS, The California State Legislature will consider Assembly Bill 26, which was introduced by Assembly Member Migden and Senate Bill 75, which was introduced by Senator Murray; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 75 would enact the Domestic Partnership Act of 1999; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 75 and Assembly Bill 26 would define "domestic partners," provide for the registration of domestic partnerships with the Secretary of State, and require health facilities to allow a patient's domestic partner and other specified persons to visit a patient; and,

WHEREAS, The Domestic Partnership Act would also revise existing law to provide for the participation of a domestic partner in the establishment of conservatorships; and,

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 26 and Senate Bill 75 are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 982139; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco endorses Assembly Bill 26 and Senate Bill 75 and urges the Legislature and Governor to approve this legislature; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the delegation from San Francisco in the

State Legislature, as well as Governor-elect Gray Davis, with a request they all take action necessary to achieve the objectives of this resolution.
