WHEREAS, The Department of Human Services has stated existing facilities to shelter the homeless in San Francisco are already at full capacity; and,

WHEREAS, It is imperative that emergency temporary facilities be located to house these San Franciscans during this bone-chilling holiday season; and,

WHEREAS, The crisis face the homeless was debated at the full board hearing on December 21, 1998 and was agreed that immediate action needed to be taken and brought to the attention of the Mayor's office; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the office of the Mayor to declare a state of emergency for the City and County of San Francisco, and let it be

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors also calls upon City departments to locate temporary emergency shelter resources for any unsheltered families living on the streets, and, let, be it
