WHEREAS, In 1995 the Board of Supervisors approved a new Article XIX for the City's Administrative Code, which created a Family Violence Advisory Council, a permanent advisory body to the Board of Supervisors, which submits recommendations to the Board for addressing the problems of family violence; and

WHEREAS, With the completion of the Task Force's report and the creation of the Family Violence Advisory Council, there is no further need for the Task Force to continue; now, therefore, be it
