-FEBRUARY-1998 VIETNAMESE TET FESTIVAL.

January 25, 1998

WHEREAS, The February 1998 TET festival celebrated the unique diversity of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, The TET festival, sponsored by the Vietnamese Community Center of San Francisco, is a celebration of the Vietnamese New Year, and presents the native culture of San Francisco's Vietnamese community; and,

WHEREAS, The holding of the TET festival requires the closure of streets within San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, The Vietnamese Community Center is a non-profit organization and, due to financial hardship, is unable to pay these fees; and,

WHEREAS, The associated cost of the street closure for this festival is \$949.74; and,

WHEREAS, The Vietnamese Community Center did not benefit fiscally from holding the festival, but rather has aided the City by providing the opportunity to celebrate the diversity of San Francisco, and indeed subsidized the costs of the festival; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives Police Department, Fire Department, and Department of Parking and Traffic fees that would otherwise be charged to the Vietnamese Community Center.
