Resolution urging 108<sup>th</sup> U.S Congress to pass the AgJobs Act of 2003 for seasonal immigrant farm workers.

WHEREAS, More than 250,000 seasonal immigrant farm workers help to sustain California's agricultural economy by laboring in one of our nation's hardest and lowest paid jobs; and,

WHEREAS, Currently, a great number of these taxpaying workers are undocumented, have no legal recourse, and are frequently subjected to substandard working conditions that foster pesticide poisoning, cancer, and birth defects; and,

WHEREAS, The U.S. House of Representatives Bill H.R.3142, and Senate Bill S.1645, known as the AgJobs Act of 2003, will stabilize the farm industry for employers, and allow temporary immigrant workers to secure permanent resident status based on three to six years of service in agricultural jobs; and,

WHEREAS, This Act would allow seasonal immigrant farm workers access to important job protections because the nature of their work is very physically demanding and can be dangerous; and,

WHEREAS, The United Farm Workers Union and a coalition of several agricultural employers support the AgJobs Act of 2003; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby strongly urge the 108<sup>th</sup> Congress to pass the AgJobs Act of 2003 during the current session and provide seasonal farm workers in California and across the nation the rights they deserve for all they contribute to our nation's agricultural industries.
