Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept and expend retroactively a two-year grant from Kaiser Permanente in the amount of \$150,000 for the project entitled "Shape Up BVHP," for the period of October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2009, which includes a subcontract with the SF Study Center for \$130,610 for the same time period.

WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from Kaiser Permanente in the amount of \$150,000, for the period of October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, The grant supports chronic disease prevention utilizing community and school-based gardens in Bayview Hunters Point (BVHP) and builds on a previous grant that funded a planning process with parents and teachers at Bret Harte Elementary school; and,

WHEREAS, The grant includes a subcontract with the SF Study Center for \$130,610 to act as fiscal agent; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the University of California requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>071676</u>; which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses the department for an existing position, Health Educator (Job Class #2819) at .10 FTE; and,

WHEREAS, The indirect costs are not included in the budget in order to maximize use of grant funds on direct services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$150,000 from California Kaiser Permanente; and, be it
