

1 [Grant to support acute HIV infection detection.]

3 Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept  
4 and expend retroactively a grant from the California HIV/AIDS Research Program of the  
5 University of California in the amount of \$213,498 for the project entitled "Acute HIV  
6 Infection Detection in San Francisco and San Mateo," for the period of October 1, 2007  
7 through December 31, 2008, which includes a subcontract with the San Mateo County  
8 Health Department for \$31,481 for the same time period.

10 WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from the California HIV/AIDS Research  
11 Program of the University of California in the amount of \$213,498, for the period of October 1,  
12 2007 through December 31, 2008; and,

13 WHEREAS, The primary aim of the project is to reduce HIV transmission in San  
14 Francisco and the surrounding Bay Area counties by developing HIV-centered prevention  
15 strategies that can be implemented in doctor's offices, clinics and medical centers; and,

16 WHEREAS, The grant includes a subcontract with the San Mateo County Health  
17 Department for \$31,481 to pay for 20 percent of the salary of a laboratory technician at the  
18 San Mateo County Laboratory; and,

19 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the University of California  
20 requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with  
21 the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 071630; which is hereby declared to be a  
22 part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

23 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses the  
24 department for existing positions, including Microbiologist (Job Class #2462) at .50 FTE,

1 Epidemiologist II (Job Class #2803) at .20 FTE, and Health Worker II (Job Class #2586) at .25  
2 FTE; and,

3 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of  
4 \$14,349; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a grant  
6 in the amount of \$213,498 from California HIV/AIDS Research Program of the University of  
7 California; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
9 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,  
10 be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions  
12 funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when  
13 the agreement expires; and, be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
15 agreement on behalf of the City.


