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AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO RETROACTIVELY APPLY FOR ACCEPT AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF \$140,000 AVAILABLE THROUGH THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING FOR A PROJECT ENTITLED "THREAT MANAGEMENT/STALKING VERTICAL PROSECUTION" FOR THE TWELVE MONTH PERIOD SEPTEMBER 1, 1999 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2000, AND WAIVING INDIRECT COST DUE TO FUNDING CONSTRAINTS.

WHEREAS, The District Attorney and the City and County of San Francisco desires to undertake a project designated the Threat Management/Stalking Vertical Prosecution Program to be funded in part from funds made available through the California Penal Code Section 13837 and 13813 administered by the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning (OCJP); and

WHEREAS, this project will investigate and vertically prosecute cases of stalking against women, their children or other family members; now,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the District Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized retroactively, on its behalf to submit the attached proposal to OCJP, and is authorized to sign and approve on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the attached Grant Award Agreement including any extensions or amendments thereof except as any amendment would

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increase any hard matching fund obligation of the City and County of San Francisco pursuant to the contract; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the applicant agrees to provide all matching funds required for said project under the program and the funding terms and conditions of OCJP and that the in-kind match will be appropriated as required; and

BE IT FURTHER REVOLVED, that is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency. The State of California and the Office of Criminal Justice Planning disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the District Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized to retroactively and retroactively, apply for accept and expend funds made available through the Office of Criminal Justice Planning for a project entitled "Threat management/Stalking Vertical Prosecution" in the amount of \$140,000 for the twelve month period September 1, 1999 through August 31, 2000, and waiving indirect cost due to funding constraints; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the three new positions authorized under the grant shall be designated as "G" or "Grant-funded" positions, which would terminate when the grant expires.
