WHEREAS, Members of the Ku Klux Klan and the American Nazi party raided the gathering, opening fire on the marchers from inside pickup trucks, killing five and wounding eleven; and,

WHEREAS, News of the Greensboro Massacre was swept off the front page by the taking of hostages in Iran; and,

WHEREAS, Noted playwright Emily Mann, author of the play *Execution of Justice* which chronicles the assassinations of Harvey Milk and George Moscone, has written a new play called *Greensboro* which recalls the events surrounding the Massacre in the words of victims, witnesses and perpetrators; and,

WHEREAS, Unconditional Theater will present the West Coast premiere of *Greensboro* at San Francisco's Center for African and African American Culture and Art from October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1999 to November 20<sup>th</sup>, 1999; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco commemorates the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Greensboro Massacre and declares November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1999 Greensboro Massacre Remembrance Day in San Francisco.
