FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the janitorial contractors, building owners and SEIU Local 87 to use all of their resources to reach a successful conclusion to their negotiations so that good janitorial jobs will be maintained and that the citywide job-training program can continue and flourish; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urge all parties involved to reach a successful and timely conclusion to their negotiations so that citywide services and commerce will continue to grow and prosper to the benefit of all.
