2 SUPPORTING ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 26 (HONDA).

4 WHEREAS, San Francisco is a diverse City; and,

5 WHEREAS, Asians and Asian Pacific Islander Americans comprise a
6 great part of San Francisco's population; and,

7 WHEREAS, Chinese and Chinese Americans make up a majority of the
8 Asian and Asian Pacific Islander American population; and,

9 WHEREAS, In light of the recent allegations of Chinese espionage
10 and illegal campaign contributions, the loyalty of Chinese, Chinese
11 Americans and other Asian Pacific Islander Americans have been
12 questioned; and,

13 WHEREAS, Asians and Asian Pacific Islander Americans are as
14 loyal to the government of the United States of America as any other
15 American; and,

16 WHEREAS, AJR 26 would request every American to avoid
17 generalizing, stereotyping, or attributing the actions of an
18 individual to an entire group; and,

19 WHEREAS, AJR 26 would reaffirm that Asian Pacific Islander
20 Americans are entitled to the same rights and privileges afforded all
21 Americans; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County
23 of San Francisco supports AJR 26; and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the local
25 delegation of the State Assembly to support AJR 26.
