AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, COMMUNITY HEALTH NETWORK, TO ACCEPT RETROACTIVELY AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$71,000 FROM THE CALIFORNIA YOUTH AUTHORITY FOR THE SECOND CHANCE TATTOO REMOVAL PROGRAM AND TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WHICH DOES NOT INCLUDE PATENT INFRINGEMENT INDEMNIFICATION AND FALSE CLAIMS CLAUSES; WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS AND PROVIDING FOR RATIFICATION OF ACTION PREVIOUSLY TAKEN.

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health, Community Health Network, San Francisco General Hospital, Specialty and Diagnostic Services, has applied for and been awarded a grant from The California Youth Authority in the amount of \$71,000 to fund the Second Chance Tattoo Removal Program, and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the California Youth Authority requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 991313; and,

WHEREAS, The California Youth Authority has indicated that it will not agree to any modification to the form of the Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, The Agreement does not contain certain provisions described below, which are required under the Administrative Code unless waived by the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Sections 6.21 and 21.19 of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include an indemnification by the California Youth Authority of the City for the infringement of patent rights; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Section 6.57 (c) of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include a paragraph reciting the false claim provisions contained in Section 6.57 (a) of the Administrative Code; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Public Health to enter into similar agreements with the California Youth Authority if the grant recurs or is renewed; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive indirect costs; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That although the City has incurred no legal obligation, the Board of Supervisors does hereby ratify the action previously taken.
