## [Grant Award - Ford Foundation]

AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO, RETROACTIVELY, ACCEPT AND EXPEND ONE-TIME FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$120,000 FROM THE FORD FOUNDATION TO SUPPORT THE FIRST OFFENDER PROSTITUTION PROGRAM AND WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS DUE TO FUNDING CONSTRAINTS.

WHEREAS, the District Attorney's Office of the City and County of San Francisco administers a collaborative program together with the San Francisco Police Department, Department of Public Health and the SAGE Project entitled the First Offender Prostitution Program (FOPP); and

WHEREAS, FOPP implements an innovative alternative approach to prostitution offenses and provides diversion opportunities and services to both prostitutes and customers of prostitutes; and

WHEREAS, FOPP was selected among over 1,500 programs nationwide as a 1997 finalist and a 1998 award winner in the Innovations in American Government Awards Program, a collaboration between the Ford Foundation, Harvard's John F. Kennedy School of Government, and the Council for Excellence in Government; and

WHEREAS, as a 1997 finalist, FOPP received a \$20,000 Ford Foundation grant and, as a 1998 award winner, FOPP received a \$100,000 Ford Foundation grant, and

WHEREAS, no matching funds are required for this grant award, and WHEREAS, the entire Ford Foundation grant award must fund activities directly related

to communication and replication of FOPP, it is requested that indirect costs be waived; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes the District Attorney to, retroactively, accept and expend \$120,000 from the Ford Foundation to support the First Offender Prostitution Program, and waiving indirect costs due to funding constraints.
