AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, COMMUNITY HEALTH NETWORK, SPECIAL PROGRAMS FOR YOUTH, TO ENTER RETROACTIVELY INTO A SUBCONTRACT AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,785 WITH THE LARKIN STREET YOUTH CENTER, THE PRIMARY CONTRACTOR, TO PROVIDE SUPPORT PERSONNEL TO THE LARKIN STREET YOUTH CENTER HIV SPECIALTY CLINIC, WHICH DOES NOT INCLUDE PATENT INFRINGEMENT INDEMNIFICATION AND FALSE CLAIMS CLAUSES; WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS; PROVIDING FOR RATIFICATION OF ACTION PREVIOUSLY TAKEN.

WHEREAS, The Larkin Street Youth Center has received funds from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) under its Ryan White CARE Title IV Adolescent Services Initiative; and,

WHEREAS. The Larkin Street Youth Center as the primary contractor, has requested that the Department of Public Health, Community Health Network, Special Programs for Youth, enter into a subcontract to participate in this project; and,

Larkin Street Youth Center

WHEREAS, The University of California has agreed to reimburse the Department of

Public Health, Community Health Network, Special Programs for Youth, in the amount of \$22,785 under the terms of this subcontract; and,

WHEREAS. The subcontract specifies that the Department of Public Health, Community Health Network, Special Programs for Youth, is to provide support personnel for the medical clinic at the Larkin Street Youth Center's HIV program service site under the term of the subcontract; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds, the Larkin Street Youth Center requires the City to enter into a subcontract agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 991219; and,

WHEREAS. The Larkin Street Youth Center has indicated that it will not agree to any modification to the form of the Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, The Agreement does not contain certain provisions described below, which are required under the Administrative Code unless waived by the Board of Supervisors; and,

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, The Larkin Street Youth Center does not allow for indirect costs for this Agreement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health. Community Health Network, Special Programs for Youth, is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into an Agreement in the amount of \$22,785 with the Larkin Street Youth Center, the primary contractor, for provision of support personnel; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Sections 6.21 and 21.19 of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include an indemnification by the Larkin Street Youth Center for the infringement of patent rights; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Section 6.57(c) of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include a paragraph reciting the false claim provisions contained in Section 6.57 (a) of the Administrative Code; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive indirect costs; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That although the City has incurred no legal obligation, the Board of Supervisors does hereby ratify the action previously taken; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Public Health to enter into similar agreements with the Larkin Street Youth Center if the Agreement recurs or is renewed.
