WHEREAS, The report of the San Francisco Park and Open Space Program, Fiscal Year 1999-2000, was approved and adopted by both the Recreation and Park Commission and the City Planning Commission, meeting jointly on May 13, 1999; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That pursuant to Charter Section 16.107(d), the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby concurs with the recommendations of the Acting General Manager of the Recreation and Park Department, including any recommended reallocations and rescission of allocations, which recommendations were approved by the Recreation and Park Commission and the City Planning Commission jointly on May 13, 1999; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this concurrence is made with the reservation of the Board of Supervisors to approve or disapprove any specific acquisition for which funding might be provided in the 1999-2000 Open Space budget.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the City receives funds from private sources that can be devoted to King Pool in excess of the amount required to complete its construction, those funds would be used to replace funds reprogrammed from Esprit Park.
