WHEREAS, A survey of the historic resources of North Beach was completed in 1982 and the results published in a 2-volume report entitled "North Beach, San Francisco: An Architectural, Historical Cultural Survey" ("North Beach Survey"); and

WHEREAS, The North Beach Survey is the product of a federal grant pursuant to the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and was carried out under a formal contract with the California State Office of Historic Preservation ("OHP") and as such, produced survey findings meeting both state and federal guidelines established by the OHP and the National Park Service; the final survey results were reviewed and approved by OHP and incorporated into the California Historical Resources Inventory System, the official compilation of all identified and evaluated historical resources in California; and

WHEREAS, The North Beach Survey was conducted with the support of the Planning Commission, the Director of the Planning Department, the Office of the Mayor and the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board by architectural historians meeting the Secretary of the Interior's Professional Qualifications; and

WHEREAS, The California State Office of Historic Preservation and the Foundation for San Francisco's Architectural Heritage have urged the Board of Supervisors to recognize the North Beach Survey; and

WHEREAS, The North Beach Survey is the most comprehensive record of the historical and architectural resources in North Beach available and is an important addition to

previously recognized historical and architectural surveys of the City's resources; now, therefore, be it
