3	Resolution urging local and State officials to support the Supplemental Nutrition
4	Assistance Program and its critical impact on the low-income residents of the City and
5	County of San Francisco.

7	WHEREAS, The United States House of Representatives are currently considering
8	cutting \$40 billion in the next ten years to the structure of the benefits provided by the
9	Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as the Federal Food
10	Stamp Program, our nation's first line of defense against hunger; and
11	WHEREAS, Over three million residents in the state of California, and over 37,000 San
12	Francisco currently receive assistance from SNAP and California's CalFresh Program; and
13	WHEREAS, SNAP not only benefits low-income families, it also spurs local economic
14	activity and supports business that serve our low and moderate-income communities, and
15	Moody's Analytics estimates that every dollar spent in SNAP benefits generates \$1.71 in
16	economic activity; and, therefore, be it
17	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors calls on all Local and State
18	officials to continue supporting the SNAP, and urge House members to vote no on any
19	reductions to the SNAP program, and, be it
20	FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution will be forwarded to the United
21	States House of Representatives.
