[Approval of a 60 Day Extension for Planning Commission Review of Planning Code - Expanding Formula Retail Controls (File No. 130788)]

Resolution extending by 60 days the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on an Ordinance (File No. 130788) amending the Planning Code to expand the definition of formula retail to include businesses that have eleven or more outlets worldwide, and to include businesses 50% or more owned by formula retail businesses; to expand the applicability of formula retail controls to other types of retail uses; to expand the notification procedures for formula retail applications; to require an economic impact report as part of the formula retail conditional use application; and making environmental findings and findings of consistency with the General Plan and the eight priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1.

WHEREAS, On July 30, 2013, Supervisor Mar introduced legislation amending the San Francisco Planning Code to expand the definition of formula retail to include businesses that have eleven or more outlets worldwide, and to include businesses 50% or more owned by formula retail businesses; to expand the applicability of formula retail controls to other types of retail uses; to expand the notification procedures for formula retail applications; to require an economic impact report as part of the formula retail conditional use application; and making environmental findings and findings of consistency with the General Plan and the eight priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1.; and

WHEREAS, On August 8, 2013, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors referred the proposed ordinance to the Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by Resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code that the Board of Supervisors initiates; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Mar has requested additional time to allow the Planning Commission and the public to review the proposed Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Planning Commission additional time to review the proposed Ordinance and render its decision; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That by this Resolution, the Board hereby extends the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed Ordinance for an additional 60 days, until January 7, 2014.
