[Buck Delventhal Day - November 20, 2013]

Resolution declaring November 20, 2013, as Buck Delventhal Day in San Francisco in recognition of his receipt of two prestigious awards honoring his contributions in the field of municipal law and his longstanding service and ongoing leadership in the San Francisco City Attorney's Office.

WHEREAS, Burk E. Delventhal, known to all as Buck, joined the San Francisco City Attorney's Office as a Deputy City Attorney on June 17, 1970, and has faithfully served the City and County of San Francisco in that capacity for more than 43 years; and

WHEREAS, During that time, Buck Delventhal has served under four City Attorneys, and has provided legal advice to eight Mayors, 82 members of the Board of Supervisors, and countless City officers and employees; and

WHEREAS, For many years, Buck Delventhal has been widely recognized throughout California and the country for his expertise in municipal law; and

WHEREAS, During his decades of public service, Buck Delventhal has been an inspiring teacher and treasured mentor for generations of municipal lawyers, and he continues to play that role in the City Attorney's Office and as an adjunct professor at University of California Hastings College of Law; and

WHEREAS, Buck Delventhal is known for regaling colleagues, clients and anyone else willing to listen with tales of his City Hall experiences, arcane details about San Francisco history, and the benefits of early morning Bay swimming; and

WHEREAS, On October 1, 2013, the International Municipal Lawyers Association awarded Buck Delventhal its Charles S. Rhyne Lifetime Achievement Award. This award is

WHEREAS, Buck Delventhal's receipt of the Charles S. Rhyne Lifetime Achievement Award and the Ronald M. George Public Lawyer of the Year Award brings honor not only to him but also to the Office of the City Attorney and to the City and County of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The people of San Francisco have benefitted immeasurably from the legal advice and representation that Buck Delventhal has provided to the City over the past 43 years; and

WHEREAS, Buck Delventhal is extraordinary for his deep knowledge, his exceptional work ethic, his professionalism, fairness, and honesty, his unflagging energy, his teaching and mentoring of law students and new lawyers, his enduring enthusiasm for the practice of municipal law, and his abiding love for San Francisco; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in celebration of Buck Delventhal's outstanding accomplishments and contributions to the City and County of San Francisco and his stature and continuing contributions as one of the leading municipal lawyers in this state and country, as reflected in the high honors he has received in the past two months from the International Municipal Lawyers Association and the California State Bar, the Board of Supervisors does hereby declare November 20, 2013 to be Buck Delventhal Day in San Francisco.
