Resolution authorizing Tax Collector Attorney to file suit against responsible relatives to recover value of services rendered at hospital facilities operated by the Department of Public Health.

Dear Ms. Calvillo:

The Office of The Treasurer and Tax Collector is submitting to the Board of Supervisors a resolution authorizing the Tax Collector Attorney to file a collection action against Myrta Salume to recover the amount of aid given to Arthur Salume, aka Arturo Solomon Salume, deceased, her husband. Arthur Salume received services at San Francisco General Hospital. As Arthur Salume's spouse, Myrta Salume is a "responsible relative" legally liable under California Welfare and Institutions Code Section 17300 to pay the charges for Arthur's care. The charges are as follows:

ACCOUNT NO. NAME OF PATIENT RESPONSIBLE RELATIVE \$51,308.90

The files of the Bureau of Delinquent Revenue (BDR) disclose evidence of the responsible relative's (spouse's) legal liability and financial ability to reimburse the Department of Public Health both at the time of hospitalization and at the present time for the costs of the patient's (spouse's) medical treatment.

Therefore, in order to comply with the requirements of Welfare and Institutions Code Section 17300 (attached), it is requested that the Board of Supervisors authorize the Tax Collector Attorney to commence suit against the above-named responsible relative.

A proposed resolution is attached hereto, authorizing the Tax Collector Attorney to institute legal proceedings against the above-named responsible relative, seeking recovery in full of the amount of aid given to the above-named patient.
