The Golden Gate National Recreation Area - including Fort Funston, Crissy Field, Ocean Beach, and other properties - is a critical resource for San Franciscans and others for various recreational activities. GGNRA isn't a traditional national park but rather an urban recreation area. One long-time, established recreational use of GGNRA properties is dog walking. Thousands of San Franciscans have long walked their dogs on these federal properties. The National Park Service is proposing significant restrictions on dog access at GGNRA. These restrictions would severely limit San Franciscans' ability to utilize GGNRA with their dogs and would result in a shift of many dogs to our city parks, causing over-crowding. The Board of Supervisors unanimously passed a resolution I authored to oppose the proposal. Congresswoman Jackie Speier has also expressed opposition to the proposal. Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi recently encouraged the National Park Service to extend the time period for public comment and to take into account the significant dog uses at GGNRA. Do you agree that the GGNRA plan goes too far in restricting dog

access? Will you work with the Board of Supervisors and our Fede Service to alter the plan to take into account the needs of dog owner.	•
