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3	Resolution retroactively approving emergency contract with Clean Harbors
4	Environmental Services, Inc., for environmental clean-up of soil and water and
5	regrading of the runway safety area after the crash landing of Asiana Airlines Flight 214
6	in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 for services already performed, for the period of
7	July 11, 2013, to September 19, 2013.
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9	WHEREAS, On July 6, 2013, Asiana Airlines Flight 214 attempted to land on Runway
10	28L and crashed; and
11	WHEREAS, On July 11, 2013, the Airport Director notified the Airport Commission
12	President of the emergency situation and the need to commence emergency work to
13	remediate property damage caused by the crash. The recovery effort to repair and open
14	Runway 28L required five (5) emergency contracts with different contractors to complete the
15	necessary work; and
16	WHEREAS, Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. ("Clean Harbors"), under
17	Contract No. 9394, provided emergency environmental clean up of soil, regrading of the
18	Runway Safety Area as required by the Federal Aviation Administration for operation of
19	Runway 28L, and additional clean up of the storm water drainage system that was both
20	extensive and complicated after the runway was reopened and Airport Staff and the contractor
21	were able to more fully assess the situation. The submitted invoices from Clean Harbors total
22	\$871,924.83; and
23	WHEREAS, In conformance with San Francisco Administrative Code Section 6.60,
24	Board of Supervisor's approval is required for emergency public work contracts exceeding
25	\$250,000; and

1	WHEREAS, On September 20, 2013, the Airport Director executed emergency
2	Contract No. 9394 in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 for services already completed,
3	now therefore be it
4	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves Contract No. 9394 – Emergency
5	Response Agreement with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. in an amount not to
6	exceed \$1,000,000 for services already completed.
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
