A copy of said legislation is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 130999 and is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, On or about October 16, 2013, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors referred the proposed ordinance to the Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by Resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code that the Board of Supervisors initiates; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Kim has requested additional time for the Planning Commission to review the proposed Ordinance; and
