

REVISED LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

(1/6/2014, Amended in Committee)

[Planning Code - Fulton Street Grocery Store Special Use District]

Ordinance amending Planning Code, Section 249.35A, to extend the effective date for the Fulton Street Grocery Store Special Use District; provide controls for business signs; and making environmental findings, and findings of consistency with the General Plan, and the eight priority policies of Planning Code, Section 101.1.

Existing Law

In 2008, the Board of Supervisors adopted legislation creating the Fulton Street Grocery Store Special Use District. That legislation allowed grocery stores in the district, but the legislation expired in May 2013. Planning Code Article 6 regulates on-site business signs throughout the City.

Amendments to Current Law

The Ordinance would extend the legislation until January 1, 2019. The Ordinance would also regulate the size of on-site business signs for this special use district.
