

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Anti-Human Trafficking Task Force Program - \$159,469]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Police Department to accept and expend a**
4 **grant augmentation in the amount of \$159,469, from the Governor’s Office of**
5 **Emergency Services, for the Anti-Human Trafficking Task Force Program, for the**
6 **period of October 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014.**

8 WHEREAS, The Police Department applied for and was awarded \$200,000 in funding
9 from the California Emergency Management Agency (now known as Cal OES) for the Anti-
10 Human Trafficking Task Force (HF) Program in October 2012, and has now been awarded a
11 grant augmentation in the amount of \$159,469; and

12 WHEREAS, The purpose of the grant is to support enforcement activities to expand our
13 existing multi-disciplinary task forces to improve both the law enforcement response to all
14 elements of human trafficking and the coordination between disciplines to ensure that a
15 comprehensive continuum of care is provided to the victims of human trafficking; and

16 WHEREAS, The original award period of October 1, 2012, through September 30,
17 2013, is now extended to June 30, 2014; and

18 WHEREAS, The grant does not include any provision for indirect costs; and

19 WHEREAS, The Police Department is seeking retroactive approval because it did not
20 receive the grant augmentation notice until November 26, 2013; and

21 WHEREAS, This grant does not create any new positions, and will not require an
22 amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the Police Department is authorized to retroactively accept and
24 expend a grant augmentation from the Cal OES in the amount of \$159,469; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
2 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police, or his designee, is authorized to
4 enter into the agreement on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco.
