

**LEGISLATIVE DIGEST**

[Administrative Code - Dissolving Surplus Property Citizens' Advisory Committee]

**Ordinance amending Administrative Code, Sections 23A.4, 23A.6, 23A.8, and 23A.11, and deleting Section 23A.9, to dissolve the Surplus Property Citizens' Advisory Committee.**

Existing Law

In 2004, the City established the Surplus Property Citizens' Advisory Committee to make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors regarding the use of surplus City property. The Clerk of the Board has determined that the Committee has not met since 2008.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would dissolve the Surplus Property Citizens' Advisory Committee.

Background Information

Rule 2.21 of the Board of Supervisors' Rules of Order requires the Clerk of the Board to determine and identify each year every subordinate body that has not met at least once every four months, and to ask the City Attorney to prepare legislation repealing the ordinance or resolution that created the body.
