[Administrative Code - Dissolving Community Oversight Committee Regarding Enforcement of Marijuana Offenses]

**Ordinance amending the Administrative Code, by deleting Section 12X.6, to dissolve the Community Oversight Committee Regarding Enforcement of Marijuana Offenses.**

Existing Law

In 2006, the City established the Community Oversight Committee regarding enforcement of marijuana offenses. The ordinance charged the Committee with the responsibility for monitoring and reporting to the Board of Supervisors regarding the City's implementation of Administrative Code Chapter 12X, Policy Making Marijuana Offenses the Lowest Law Enforcement Priority, and recommending policy changes to further the purposes of that Chapter. The Clerk of the Board has determined that the Committee has not met in the last two years.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would dissolve the Community Oversight Committee regarding enforcement of marijuana offenses.

Background Information

Rule 2.21 of the Board of Supervisors' Rules of Order requires the Clerk of the Board to determine and identify each year every subordinate body that has not met at least once every four months, and to ask the City Attorney to prepare legislation repealing the ordinance or resolution that created the body.

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
