[Concurring in the Continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency - Rim Fire (Stanislaus National Forest Area)]

Motion concurring in the continuation of the "Rim Fire" Revised Declaration of Local Emergency by the Mayor and in the actions taken to meet the emergency.

WHEREAS, On August 22, 2013, Acting Mayor Mark E. Farrell issued a Declaration of Local Emergency under Charter Section 3.100(14) and California Government Code Section 8630 in connection with the wildfire that began on August 17, 2013, in the Stanislaus National Forest Area (the "Rim Fire"); and

WHEREAS, On September 3, 2013, under the same statutory authorities, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-109, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 130809, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, On September 19, 2013, Mayor Edwin M. Lee issued a Revised Declaration of Local Emergency for the Rim Fire; and

WHEREAS, On September 24, 2013, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-116, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 130900, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, On October 22, 2013, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-136, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 131015, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, On November 19, 2013, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-151, on file

with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 131104, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, On December 17, 2013, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-176, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 131164, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, On January 14, 2014, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M14-005, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140003, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 8630 provides that, when a local emergency has been declared, "[t]he governing body shall review the need for continuing the local emergency at least once every 30 days until the governing body terminates the local emergency;" and

WHEREAS, Conditions threatening the lives, property or welfare of the City and County of San Francisco or its citizens continue to exist in the connection with the Rim Fire, including damage to property and equipment of San Francisco Public Utilities Commission and Recreation and Park Department resources; and


WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors does hereby find that the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril justify and require the continuation of the declaration of local emergency; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office has submitted a memorandum to the Board of Supervisors, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>140110</u>, confirming the emergency conditions and concluding that it is in the best interest of the City to continue the local emergency; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs in the continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency issued by the Mayor, and in the actions taken by the Mayor to meet the emergency; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Clerk of the Board to agendize another motion concurring in the continuation of the Rim Fire Revised Declaration of Local Emergency to be heard no later than 30 days from the date of passage of this Motion.

The Department of Emergency Management and the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) have requested that our office seek a monthly recurring item on the Board of Supervisors agenda to continue the Local Emergency related to the Rim Fire through Spring of 2014. In order to protect the Hetch Hetchy Water and Power System, the PUC continues to seek flexibility to rapidly hire contactors to repair ongoing damage to roads, power poles, and other City assets resulting from rain, snow, and associated runoff in the burn area.

Under state law, the Local Emergency must be renewed every 30 days by the Board of Supervisors or else it expires. As you know, the Board last extended the emergency on January 14, 2013. We respectfully request that this item again be calendared for Adoption Without Committee Reference on the following dates:

- February 11
- March 11
- April 8
- May 6
- June 3
