WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering grant programs require an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of the grant; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of the Department of the Environment, or a designee, to apply for all available CalRecycle grants; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of the Department of Environment, or a designee, to execute in the name of the City and County of San Francisco all documents, including but not limited to, applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements, annual reports (including expenditure reports) and amendments hereto for the purposes of securing grant

funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the program application; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That, to meet CalRecycle's requirement that San Francisco's governing body approve the submission of funding applications, the Board of Supervisors authorizes the submission of an application to CalRecycle for all available grants and payments, and this authorization shall remain in effect for five years from February 15, 2014.
