

To Supervisors Yee, Tang, and Campos:

My name is Joshua Vining, and I have reapplied for my current seat (#5) on the SRO Task Force, which I have occupied since I was originally appointed in early 2012. I applied for this seat in August of last year, but unfortunately I will be out of town during the February 6th Rules Committee meeting. For these reasons I am submitting a statement in writing regarding my interest and qualifications for serving on that body.

I have worked for the Mission SRO Collaborative since 2008, first as a community organizer, and as of last year as a program co-coordinator. I was initially drawn to doing meaningful work with chronically under-housed populations due to my own difficulty securing housing in San Francisco, as well as a deep commitment to housing justice that was cemented into my consciousness during my time living in New Orleans immediately after Hurricane Katrina. Now, more than ever, I am committed implementing real, long-term solutions to the needs in the SRO community, and I firmly believe that this is only possible by creating structures in which SRO tenants are the primary decision-makers in the City's choices and policies that affect their community.

During my time at the Mission SRO Collaborative I have conducted hundreds of hours of direct outreach in the SROs in the Mission, making relationships with tenants, correcting code violations, making referrals to our direct case management and housing counseling services, and looking to the community to identify the problems that most impact their lives to inform our campaign decisions. I have managed a project that resulted in the implementation of the 3-1-1 complaint line for SRO code violations, which remains an easy, free way for SRO tenants to place multiple code violations that span different enforcing departments. I have also worked to expand the types of IDs that are acceptable under the Uniform Visitor Policy beyond just a California ID to other types of identification that are more easily available to low income tenants.

More recently I have taken leadership in the Bedbug Working Group, which was an ad hoc group that was started due to growing community concern that the Department of Public Health's internal guidelines and policies were a barrier to effectively eliminating bedbugs. The fruit of that long labor resulted in new internal rules and regulations adopted by DPH for responding to bedbug complaints, as well as legislation that was introduced by Supervisor Kim and unanimously passed by the full board. My involvement in bedbug eradication is ongoing.

Lastly, I witness every day the effects of San Francisco's affordability crisis and how it affects low income residents. I see SROs in the Mission that are technically keeping with the letter of the law by renting out units by the week, but they are renting them to a new crowd of young, tech savvy singles who are new to the City and who view SROs as a good fit for their new lives in the big city. This results in long-time SRO tenants and low income people in general being displaced and either becoming homeless or moving out of the City. In fact, I have myself been priced out of San Francisco's rental market, and make the

commute from Oakland every day into the Mission, where my roots are, and where still feels like home. For this reason I am also requesting a residency waiver so that I can continue to participate in the work of the SRO Task Force. The rapid changes facing San Francisco and the SRO community demand quick action, and I look forward to the chance to continue my work with that body to finding new solutions and creative frameworks and partnerships that break from the established channels.

Again, my apologies for being out of town during the Rules Committee meeting, but please feel free to contact me with any questions, concerns or ideas that may help the ongoing work I'm already a part of.

The SRO Task Force consists of a total of fourteen members, nine of whom are appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors appoints nine voting members of the Task Force: two SRO tenant; two private SRO owners/operators; one non-profit SRO operator/owner; and one representative from each of the four SRO Collaboratives (Mission SRO Collaborative, Central City SRO Collaborative, Chinatown SRO Collaborative, and Families SRO Collaborative).

In addition to the above nine members, four voting members shall be appointed to the Task Force by the heads of each of the following San Francisco departments/agencies: The Director of the Human Services Agency will appoint one representative, the Director of the Department of Building Inspection will appoint one representative, the City Attorney will appoint one representative from the Code Enforcement Task Force, and the Director of the Department of Public Health will appoint one representative from Housing and Urban Health and one representative from Environmental Health. Also, the Director of the Department of Public Health will appoint one non-voting (except in the case of a tie vote) Task Force Chair.

The SRO Task Force shall monitor and make policy recommendations to the Board of Supervisors and annually produce a comprehensive report. The SRO Task Force will adopt and assist in the implementation of the following two goals:

- A. Goal 1: San Francisco SRO Hotels are safe, accessible, stable, and 'just' places to live in.
1. Identify and provide training, consultation and direct services furthering this goal.

3. Monitor compliance with relevant laws, regulations, policies and/or procedures.

B. Goal 2: Affordable, healthy, and appropriate housing options are available in San Francisco so that extremely low-income families do not have to raise their children in SRO Hotels.

1. Advocate strategies to move families out of SROs and into permanent housing.
2. Advocate goals for assuring San Francisco housing and supportive housing units are affordable to 0-25% medium income families will be advocated for.
3. Advocate strategies to prevent families from losing their housing.
4. Review San Francisco Planning Code, Administrative Code, and other pertinent City Ordinances and recommend amendments necessary to implement Goal 2.

Term of Office: Members of the SRO Task Force shall be appointed for a term of three years. In the event a vacancy occurs, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint a successor to complete the remainder of that term.

Reports: The SRO Task Force shall monitor and make policy recommendations to the Board of Supervisors and annually produce a comprehensive report.

Sunset Date: The SRO Task Force shall sunset on December 31, 2015.
