4	of equipment, software, and services from Ruckus Wireless, Inc., with a total value		
5	of \$701,894 in order to provide free wireless access to the Internet along Market

8	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco seeks to enhance Internet		
9	access to residents and visitors; and		
10	WHEREAS, Consistent with that goal, the Department of Technology ("DT") is		
11	developing a project to provide free, wireless access to the Internet along Market Street		
12	in San Francisco to any person in the vicinity with a compatible Wi-Fi device (the		
13	"Market Street Wi-Fi Project"); and		
14	WHEREAS, Ruckus Wireless, Inc. ("Ruckus"), a manufacturer of wireless		
15	infrastructure products, has donated to the City certain wireless access points,		
16	controllers, related hardware and software, and services for DT to use for the Market		
17	Street Wi-Fi Project, as set forth in the Gift Agreement between the City and Ruckus on		
18	file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 131209; and		
19	WHEREAS, DT and Ruckus have determined that the value of the wireless		
20	access points, controllers, related hardware, software, and services Ruckus has		
21	donated to the City is \$701,894 based on list prices; and		
22	WHEREAS, DT has requested retroactive approval of its acceptance of the gift		
23	from Ruckus because DT has already obtained the equipment in order to begin
