7	MOVED, That within three business days of the introduction or amendment of any
8	proposed Ordinance, Resolution, or written Motion, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall
9	make available the Ordinance, Resolution, or written Motion, including all document data
10	concerning the Board's public legislative process, on the Board's website in machine-readable
11	format. For the purpose of this Motion, "machine-readable format" shall include formats
12	consistent with the Open Data Policy rules and standards promulgated by the Chief Data
13	Officer under Administrative Code, Section 22D.2. This requirement is directory only, and
14	shall not provide a basis for invalidating any Ordinance, Resolution, or Motion adopted by the
15	Board of Supervisors.
