Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Technology to accept an in-kind gift of services necessary to improve email service to City departments from Microsoft valued at \$133,000 for the period March 21, 2014, to June 30, 2014.

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors authorized a five year Information and Technology Plan (ICT Plan) on April 16, 2013, by Resolution 116-13, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 130230, and hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, A goal in the plan was to continue the conversion of multiple email systems in the City and County of San Francisco ("City") to a single hosted email exchange system; and

WHEREAS, Consistent with the goals in the ICT Plan, the Department of Technology ("DT") has developed an email migration project that will allow public safety departments and health departments to communicate in a secure email environment; and

WHEREAS, The migration project will require additional services from Microsoft in order to transition the City's current email system to a system designed specifically for government users (G level service) that will provide a more secure environment for the City's email and comply with the regulatory frameworks established for public safety departments and health service providers; and

WHEREAS, Microsoft seeks to donate services valued at \$133,000 for DT to use for the City's migration to the G level service; and

WHEREAS, DT has agreed to use the services to implement the migration, subject to the Board of Supervisors' approval of this resolution; now, therefore, be it

2	Technology to accept the Gift from Microsoft of \$133,000 in services and use the		
3	services to migrate its hosted email services to a government level service.
