On April 2, 2014 the San Francisco Historic Preservation Commission (hereinafter "HPC") conducted a duly noticed public hearing at a regularly scheduled meeting to consider a recommendation for a change of designation of 1007 Market Street, known historically as the James G. Walker Building, to the Board of Supervisors. At the hearing, the HPC voted to approve a resolution to recommend the change of designation from a Category V (Unrated) to a Category III (Contributory) building pursuant to Article 11 of the Planning Code.

The proposed amendments have been determined to be categorically exempt from environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act Section 15060(c)(2).
