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9	WHEREAS, The Planning Department found the subject Tentative Parcel Map in
10	compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code,
11	Sections 21000 et seq.) and found it consistent with the General Plan, and priority policy
12	findings of Planning Code, Section 101.1. Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the
13	Board of Supervisors in File No. 140255 and is incorporated herein by reference; and
14	WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works, in a decision dated March 4, 2014,
15	approved a Tentative Parcel Map for a 4-lot subdivision located at 738 Mission Street,
16	Assessor's Block No. 3706, Lot No. 277. Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the
17	Board of Supervisors in File No. 140255 and is incorporated herein by reference; and
18	WHEREAS, On March 14, 2014, Thomas N. Lippe, on behalf of 765 Market Street
19	Residential Owners Association, the Friends of Yerba Buena, Paul Sedway, Ron Wornick,
20	Matthew Schoenberg, Joe Fang, and Margaret Collins, filed a timely appeal to the decision of
21	the Department of Public Works; and
22	WHEREAS, On April 8, 2014, this Board held a duly noticed public hearing to consider
23	the appeal of the Tentative Parcel Map filed by Appellants; and

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WHEREAS, This Board has reviewed and considered the subject Map, the appeal
letter, the other written records before the Board of Supervisors, and heard testimony and
received public comment regarding the subject Map; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board hereby re-adopts and incorporates by reference the environmental findings and findings of consistency with the General Plan and Planning Code, Section 101.1, it made in Ordinance No. 177-13, Board File No. 130570 concerning the project at 706 Mission Street - The Mexican Museum and Residential Tower Project ("Project") which includes a Tentative Parcel Map for a 4-lot subdivision located at 738 Mission Street, Assessor's Block No. 3706, Lot No. 277; since the Board approved the Project and made CEQA findings, the Board continues to find that there have been no substantial changes to the Project that would require major revisions to the Final EIR or result in new or substantially more severe significant environmental impacts that were not evaluated in the Final EIR; no substantial changes in circumstances have occurred that would require major revisions to the Final EIR or result in new or substantially more severe significant environmental impacts that were not evaluated in the Final EIR; no new information has become available that was not known and could not have been known at the time the Final EIR was certified as complete and that would result in new or substantially more severe significant environmental impacts not evaluated in the Final EIR; and no mitigation measures or alternatives previously found infeasible would be feasible or mitigation measures or alternatives considerably different than those analyzed in the Final EIR would substantially reduce significant environmental impacts, but the project proponent declines to adopt them; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board approves the decision of the Department of Public Works concerning the Tentative Parcel Map and hereby approves said Map.

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
