WHEREAS, The Planning Department found the subject Vesting Tentative Map in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code, Sections 21000 et seq.) and found it consistent with the General Plan and the priority policy findings of Planning Code, Section 101.1.
