

1 [Contract Amendment - State Department of Health Care Services - Substance Use Disorder Services
2 - FY2013-2014 - \$70,682,740]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health - Community Behavioral**
4 **Health Services (DPH-CBHS) to enter into an amended FY2013-2014 Contract for Substance**
5 **Use Disorder Services with the State Department of Health Care Services for the term of July 1,**
6 **2010, through June 30, 2014, in the amount of \$70,682,740 and authorizing and designating the**
7 **DPH County Alcohol and Drug Administrator to sign said Agreement and to approve**
8 **amendments for less than 10% of the contracted amount.**

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10 WHEREAS, On September 14, 2010, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors approved a
11 resolution (on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 101109) retroactively
12 authorizing DPH-CBHS to enter into a Combined Net Negotiated Amount and Drug Medi-Cal
13 Agreement with the State of California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (DADP) for the term
14 of July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2013, in the amount of \$60,402,780; and

15 WHEREAS, On June 18, 2013, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors approved a resolution
16 (on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 130494) retroactively authorizing DPH-
17 CBHS to enter into a Combined Net Negotiated Amount and Drug Medi-Cal Agreement – assigned to
18 State Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) under the FY2013-2014 Budget Act, which
19 eliminated DADP – for the term of July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2014, in the amount of \$69,008,529;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, On May 12, 2014, DHCS sent a contract amendment for substance use disorder
22 services that would (1) modify the contract Terms and Conditions and (2) increase funding by
23 \$1,674,211 for FY2013-2014 and (3) enable the contractor (the City) to provide more of the same
24 services as outlined in the original contract; and

1 WHEREAS, The DPH County Alcohol and Drug Administrator is designated to sign the
2 Combined Net Amount and Drug Medi-Cal Agreement and approve future amendments for less than
3 ten percent (10%) of the contracted amount; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That DPH-CBHS is hereby authorized to enter into an amended FY2013-2014
5 Substance Use Disorder Services Contract with DHCS for the term of July 1, 2010, through June 30,
6 2014, in the amount of \$70,682,740 that would (1) modify the contract Terms and Conditions and (2)
7 increase funding by \$1,674,211 for FY2013-2014 and (3) enable the contractor (the City) to provide
8 more of the same services as outlined in the original contract; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the DPH County Alcohol and Drug Administrator is hereby
10 authorized and designated by the Board of Supervisors to sign said Agreement and to approve
11 Agreement amendments for less than ten percent (10%) of the contracted amount.
