SUBJECT: Award of Contract No. 9230.9, Construction Management Support Services for Runway Safety Area Program to Parsons Brinckerhoff

DIRECTOR'S RECOMMENDATION: AWARD CONTRACT NO. 9230.9, CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SUPPORT SERVICES FOR RUNWAY SAFETY AREA PROGRAM, TO PARSONS BRINCKERHOFF IN AN INITIAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,600,000 FOR SERVICES THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2013

#### **Executive Summary**

Transmitted herewith for your approval is a proposed resolution awarding Contract 9230.9, Construction Management Support Services for Runway Safety Area (RSA) Program to Parsons Brinckerhoff (PB) in the initial amount of \$2,600,000 for the first year of services through October 31, 2013. The services to be provided by PB will be in support of SFO's RSA Program, to assist Airport staff in managing the various contracts, with services to include construction project scheduling, project controls and reporting, inspection, and budgeting.

#### Background

On April 17, 2012, by Resolution No. 12-0084, the Airport Commission authorized Staff to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) and negotiate a contract with the highest ranked proposer to provide construction management services for SFO's RSA program. On July 23, 2012, the Airport received four proposals. The Airport convened a three-member selection panel to review and score the proposals in accordance with the criteria stated in the RFP.

The scoring by the Selection Panel of the technical proposals is as follows:

Proposer	Score (315 Points Max)	
Parsons Brinckerhoff	286.33	
URS Corporation Americas	275.67	
Atkins North America, Inc.	260.67	
PMA Consultants LLC.	245.00	

The RFP stated that the three highest ranking respondents would be invited for oral interviews with the Selection Panel. On August 7, 2012, the Selection Panel interviewed the three firms, including key personnel of each firm and thoroughly appraised their qualifications.

The combined scoring by the Selection Panel of both the technical proposals as well as the oral interviews is as follows:

Parsons Brinckerhoff	377.67
URS Corporation Americas	367.33
Atkins North America, Inc.	350.33

Staff has successfully negotiated scope, staffing and fee with the highest ranked proposer, Parsons Brinckerhoff. The services will be billed and reimbursed on a time-and-material basis. The proposed award provides for the first year of services, through October 31, 2013, in an amount not to exceed \$2,600,000. Staff will prepare annual renewals for Commission consideration, dependent upon the quality of the services and progress of the work. The anticipated contract duration is four (4) years, with a budget of \$6,300,000.

This contract will be federally complaint, as Staff anticipates receiving federal grant funding to fund a portion of these costs, as part of the federal funding component of the RSA Program. Staff will be applying for federal grant funding over a three-year period, beginning in Federal FY 2012.

The Airport encouraged all proposers to utilize "best efforts" to contract at least ten percent (10%) of the work to certified small and disadvantaged businesses (DBE's). PB has committed to achieving 20% DBE subcontractor participation.

#### Recommendation

I recommend that the Commission approve the proposed resolution to award Contract No. 9230.9, Construction Management Support Services for the Runway Safety Area Program, to Parsons Brinckerhoff in the initial amount of \$2,600,000 for the first year of services through October 31, 2013.



WHEREAS,	the Selection Panel scored the technical proposals based on the evaluation criteria outlined in the RFP, identified the three highest ranking firms and interviewed key personnel, and scored the proposals and interviews based on the evaluation criteria, as follows:
