[Professional Services Agreement - Waiving Competitive Solicitation Requirement to Procure Specialized Environmental Services - East Harbor Marina Sediment Remediation and Facility Renovation Project - Leidos, Inc. - \$2,000,000]

Ordinance waiving the competitive solicitation requirement under Administrative Code, Section 6.40, and authorizing the General Manager of the Recreation and Park Department to enter into a professional services agreement with Leidos, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000, for the purpose of performing specialized environmental services for the San Francisco East Harbor Marina Sediment Remediation and Facility Renovation Project to commence following Board approval.

Existing Law

Section 6.40 of the Administrative Code requires Departments to procure outside temporary professional design or consultant services for public work projects greater than \$100,000 through a competitive process.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance will not amend or modify any provision of current law. Rather, the ordinance would waive the competitive solicitation requirement under Administrative Code, Section 6.40 for this specific contract and authorize the Recreation and Park Department to enter into a professional services agreement with Leidos, Inc. to perform specialized environmental services for the San Francisco East Harbor Marina Sediment Remediation and Facility Renovation Project.
