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10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	Section 1. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising existing Section
12	15.104, and renumbering it as 21.43, to read as follows:
13	SEC. <u>15.104-21.43</u> . MEMBERSHIP IN UNIVERSITY HEALTHSYSTEMS
14	CONSORTIUM AND UNIVERSITY HEALTHSYSTEMS CONSORTIUM SERVICES
15	CORPORATION.
16	The Director of Health is hereby authorized to apply and pay for membership of the
17	Department of Public Health ("DPH") in the University HealthSystems Consortium and the
18	University HealthSystems Consortium Services Corporation. Upon obtaining membership, <i>the</i>
19	Department of Public Health DPH is authorized to utilize all services provided by the University
20	HealthSystems Consortium and the University HealthSystems Consortium Services
21	Corporation including, but not limited to, the Purchasing Program and the clinical and financial
22	databases. The Director of Health is authorized to enter into and execute written agreements
23	on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco with the University HealthSystems
24	Consortium and the University HealthSystems Consortium Services Corporation. The Director
25	of Health is also authorized to enter into and execute written agreements, including operating

1 <u>lease agreements for equipment</u>, and execute purchase orders on behalf of the City and County 2 of San Francisco with suppliers of goods and materials, <u>and/or finance entities affiliated with</u> 3 <u>those suppliers</u>, selected by the University HealthSystems Consortium Services Corporation 4 through its competitive bidding process. Said agreements and purchase orders shall be 5 governed by the terms of the University HealthSystems Consortium Services Corporation's 6 standard terms and conditions. <u>DPH may consult with the Office of Public Finance on agreements</u> 7 to which a supplier's finance entity is a party.

8 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after 9 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the 10 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board 11 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

- Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
