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[Treasure Island Development Authority Budget - FYs 2014-2015 and 2015-2016]

Resolution approving the Budget of the Treasure Island Development Authority for FYs 2014-2015 and 2015-2016.

WHEREAS, On May 2, 1997, the Board of Supervisors passed Resolution No. 380-97 authorizing the Mayor's Treasure Island Project Office to establish a nonprofit public benefit corporation known as the Treasure Island Development Authority (the "Authority") to act as a single entity focused on the planning, redevelopment, reconstruction, rehabilitation, reuse and conversion of the former Naval Station Treasure Island; and

WHEREAS, Under the Treasure Island Conversion Act of 1997 (AB 699), the California legislature, among other things, designated the Authority as a redevelopment agency with all of the rights, powers, privileges, immunities, authorities, and duties granted to a redevelopment agency pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment Law, Health and Safety Code, Section 33000, et seq. (the "Redevelopment Law") upon approval of the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved the designation of the Authority as a redevelopment agency with powers over the former Naval Station Treasure Island in Resolution 43-98 on February 6, 1998; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors rescinded designation of the Authority as the redevelopment agency for Treasure Island under California Community Redevelopment Law in Resolution No. 11-12, but such rescission does not affect Authority's status as the Local Reuse Authority for Treasure Island or the tidelands trust trustee for the portions of Treasure Island subject to the tidelands trust, or any of the other powers or authority of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, The Authority has submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval its annual budget for FYs 2014-2015 and 2015-2016, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140639 (the Budget); and

WHEREAS, The Authority hereby requests that such approval be granted, and the Board of Supervisors is agreeable to doing so; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby approve the Budget of the Authority for FYs 2014-2015 and 2015-2016.

WHEREAS, Former Naval Station Treasure Island is a military base located on Treasure Island and Yerba Buena Island (together, the "Base"), which is currently owned by the United States of America (the "Navy"); and,

WHEREAS, The Base was selected for closure and disposition by the Base Realignment and Closure Commission in 1993, acting under Public Law 101-510, and its subsequent amendments; and,

WHEREAS, On May 2, 1997, the Board of Supervisors passed Resolution No. 380-97, authorizing the Mayor's Treasure Island Project Office to establish a nonprofit public benefit corporation known as the Treasure Island Development Authority (the "Authority") to act as a single entity focused on the planning, redevelopment, reconstruction, rehabilitation, reuse and conversion of the Base for the public interest, convenience, welfare and common benefit of the inhabitants of the City and County of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, Under the Treasure Island Conversion Act of 1997, which amended Section 33492.5 of the California Health and Safety Code and added Section 2.1 to Chapter 1333 of the Statutes of 1968 (the "Act"), the California Legislature (i) designated the Authority as a redevelopment agency under California redevelopment law with authority over the Base upon approval of the City's Board of Supervisors, and (ii) with respect to those portions of the Base which are subject to the Tidelands Trust, vested in the Authority the authority to administer the public trust for commerce, navigation and fisheries as to such property; and,

WHEREAS, On January 24, 2012, the Board of Supervisors rescinded designation of 1 the Authority as the redevelopment agency for Treasure Island under California Community 2 3 Redevelopment Law in Resolution No. 11-12; and that such rescission does not affect Authority's status as the Local Reuse Authority for Treasure Island or the Tidelands Trust 4 trustee for the portions of Treasure Island subject to the Tidelands Trust, or any of the other 5 powers or authority; and 6 7 WHEREAS, As provided under the Authority's Bylaws, the Director of Island 8 Operations has prepared a budget for the Authority for Fiscal Year 2014-2016, a copy of 9 which is attached to this resolution as Exhibit A -Exhibit F (the "FY 2014-2016 Budget Submittal"); now therefore be it 10 11 RESOLVED, That the Board of Directors of the Authority hereby adopts and approves 12 the FY 2014-2016 Budget Submittal, and hereby authorizes the Directors of Treasure Island 13 to (1) enter into work orders with City Departments for services that are consistent with the 14 FY2014-2016 Budget, and (2) enter into Professional Service Contracts and (3) Agreements with Service Providers through the FY 2014-16 Budget Cycle. 15 16 17 CERTIFICATE OF SECRETARY I hereby certify that I am the duly elected Secretary of the Treasure Island 18 19 Development Authority, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, and that the 20 above Resolution was duly adopted and approved by the Board of Directors of the 21 Authority at a properly noticed meeting on May 14, 2014. 22 23 24
