[Approving Expenditures - Budget Savings Incentive Fund - FYs 2014-2015 and 2015-2016]

Resolution approving expenditures from the Budget Savings Incentive Fund for one-time purposes in FYs 2014-2015 and 2015-2016.

WHEREAS, Section 10.20 of the San Francisco Administrative Code established a Budget Savings Incentive Fund to encourage City Departments to implement cost-saving incentives and allow for the reinvestment of those savings in one-time expenditures that improve the efficiency of departmental operations, reduce the cost of service delivery, generate additional revenue, or meet deferred maintenance needs; and

WHEREAS, At the close of FY2012-2013, \$24.8 million was available in the Fund from savings generated by General Fund Departments and the Controller assumes additional deposits of \$21.0 million from departmental expenditure savings projected for FY2013-2014, offset by \$16.7 million in budgeted uses of the Fund in FY2013-14, for a total estimated balance of \$29.1 million; and

WHEREAS, Departments have made proposals for one-time and efficiency proposals to the Capital Planning Committee and the Committee on Information Technology; and

WHEREAS, Through these committees, expenditure proposals have been approved by the Mayor's Budget Director, the Controller and the President of the Board of Supervisors or their designees; and

WHEREAS, The expenditure proposals of \$29.1 million have been included in the Mayor's proposed FY2014-2015 budget and zero expenditure for the FY2015-2016 budget, and a listing is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140633, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the use of the Budget Savings Incentive Fund as a funding source for identified one-time expenditures for FYs 2014-2015 and 2015-2016.
