WHEREAS, Mrs. Licavoli's career began in 1970, when the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) contacted San Francisco's St. Paul's High School looking for the most accomplished typing and shorthand graduate, and Madeleine was recommended for the temporary position; and

WHEREAS, Shortly after joining the PUC, Madeleine was bumped to MUNI, which the PUC didn't take lightly and started a tug o' war with MUNI to steal her back to the PUC, and Madeleine was ultimately restored back to the PUC; and

WHEREAS, To get above the fray, Madeleine carved out a promotional opportunity as the Secretary to the Chief Probation Officer at the Juvenile Court; only 14 years later to find herself in the midst of a second tug o' war when Chief Jordan accused Mary Burns, the General Manager of the Recreation and Park Department, of "stealing" Madeleine, which was true; and
