[Concurring in the Continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency - Rim Fire (Stanislaus National Forest Area)]

Motion concurring in the continuation of the "Rim Fire" Revised Declaration of Local Emergency by the Mayor and in the actions taken to meet the emergency.

WHE REAS, On August 22, 2013, Acting Mayor Mark E. Farrell issued a Declaration of Local Emergency under Charter, Section 3.100(14), and California Government Code, Section 8630, in connection with the wildfire that began on August 17, 2013, in the Stanislaus National Forest Area (the "Rim Fire"); and

WHE REAS, On September 3, 2013, under the same statutory authorities, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-109, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 130809, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, On September 19, 2013, Mayor Edwin M. Lee issued a Revised Declaration of Local Emergency for the Rim Fire; and

WHEREAS, On September 24, 2013, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-116, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 130900, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, On October 22, 2013, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-136, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 131015, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

WHE REAS, Government Code, Section 8630, provides that, when a local emergency has been declared, "[t]he governing body shall review the need for continuing the local emergency at least once every 30 days until the governing body terminates the local emergency;" and

WHE REAS, Conditions threatening the lives, property or welfare of the City and County of San Francisco or its citizens continue to exist in the connection with the Rim Fire, including damage to property and equipment of San Francisco Public Utilities Commission and Recreation and Park Department resources; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors does hereby find that the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril justify and require the continuation of the declaration of local emergency; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office has submitted a memorandum to the Board of Supervisors, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140720, confirming the emergency conditions and concluding that it is in the best interest of the City to continue the local emergency; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs in the continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency issued by the Mayor, and in the actions taken by the Mayor to meet the emergency; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Clerk of the Board to agendize a successive motion concurring in the continuation of the Rim Fire Revised Declaration of Local Emergency to be heard no later than 30 days from the date of passage of this Motion.

Dear Ms. Calvillo,

At the recommendation of the Department of Emergency Management and the Public Utilities Commission (PUC), Mayor Lee requests to extend the monthly recurring item on the Board of Supervisors agenda to continue the Local Emergency related to the Rim Fire through the end of 2014. In order to protect the Hetch Hetchy Water and Power System, the PUC continues to seek flexibility to rapidly hire contactors to repair ongoing damage to roads, power poles, and other City assets resulting from rain, snow, and associated runoff in the burn area. In addition, the PUC continues to seek FEMA reimbursement for ongoing repairs to the Lower Cherry Aqueduct, a critical asset in the Hetch Hetchy water system that was heavily damaged by the Rim Fire and is essential to our drought response planning.

Under state law, the Local Emergency must be renewed every 30 days by the Board of Supervisors or else it expires. As you know, the Board is currently scheduled to consider a final extension to the emergency on June 3, 2014. We respectfully request that this item again be calendared for Adoption Without Committee Reference on the following dates:

- June 24
- July 22
- September 2
- September 30
- October 28
- November 25
- December 16

In addition, because the Board of Supervisors is not scheduled to meet for more than 30 days during the August recess, we anticipate that Mayor Lee will issue a Second Revised Declaration of Local Emergency during that time, before August 21, so that the Local Emergency will not expire.
